

The Job Access and Reverse Commute and New Freedom Grant Programs

Delaware Transit Corporation (DART) has been awarded JARC funding to provide bus service to low-income areas and reverse commute trips in New Castle County. The Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) program addresses unique transportation challenges faced by welfare recipients and low-income persons seeking employment. Many entry-level jobs are located in suburban areas, and low-income individuals have difficulty accessing these jobs from their inner city, urban, or rural neighborhoods.

DART also participates in the New Freedom grant program that aims to provide tools to overcome existing barriers facing Americans with disabilities seeking integration into the work force and full participation in society. Lack of adequate transportation is a primary barrier to work for individuals with disabilities. The New Freedom grant program seeks to reduce barriers to transportation services and expand transportation mobility options available to people with disabilities.
