

Newark Transit Hub Now Open

- The NEW Newark Transit Hub located between Delaware Avenue and Main Street is now open, resulting in service adjustments to Routes 6, 33, 34, 39, 55 and 65.
- Route 6 begins/ends at the Newark Transit Hub, no longer serving Newark Municipal Building; however, passengers can transfer to the Route 31 – Newark Trolley or Route 33 to get to Elkton Rd. Passengers who take 3 or more trips/day should purchase a Daily Pass from the Driver for \$2.40 for the best value. Daily Passes can be purchased with cash, or save even more by using a DARTCard.
- Route 31 - Newark Trolley serves bus stops on Main St., adjacent to Newark Shopping Center, and onsite at the Newark Transit Hub on Pomeroy Lane. The promotional fare of 25¢ will remain in effect due to a subsidy from the City of Newark.
- Routes 33 & 39 extends to the Newark Transit Hub via Delaware Avenue, and no longer serves South College Ave. between Delaware Ave. and W. Park Place.
- Route 34 ends at the Newark Transit Hub, no longer serving S. College Ave.
- Route 55 extends non-peak trips from Glasgow to Newark, serving bus stops on Main St., adjacent to Newark Shopping Center, and on Delaware Ave., adjacent to the Newark Transit Hub.
- Route 65 has been realigned to serve Bank of America – Deerfield site on Paper Mill Road (SR 72), eliminating the eastern portion of the route, no longer serving Avon, or the White Clay Center on SR 273 due to low ridership. Route 65 serves the Newark Transit Hub.
